# TOK

"Main Street" Alaska

We are pleased that you have chosen to spend some time in our small community. Our residents number 1214, and our elevation is 1635'.

We are the trade center for the Athabascan Native villages of Northway, Tetlin, Tanacross, Mentasta, Eagle and Dot Lake. Alaskan made Native arts and crafts may be found in many of our gift shops.

Tok originated as an Alaska Road Commission camp for the construction of the Alcan and Glenn Highways in the 1940s. Tok was designated a Presidential Townsite in 1946, the same year the Alcan was open to civilians, and a roadhouse was opened in the community. In 1954, Tok Dog Musher's Association was founded, and the U.S. Army began construction of the 8" Haines-Fairbanks fuel pipeline, with a pump station located here that operated until 1979. U.S. Customs moved from Tok to its present location in 1971.

Milepost 1324 leads to the Tanacross Native Village and the Tanacross Airport. The village is where the Eagle Trail crossed the Tanana River. Sternwheelers once plied this river. The large paved airstrip was built during WWII to handle aircraft being ferried to Russia. It remains a base for summer fire fighting crews.

The Tok Race of Champions Sled Dog Race, one of the oldest in the state, is held each March. Tok is one of the centers of dog breeding, training and mushing. Tok is a winter playground for snowmachiners, with many snowmobile activities.

In the past few years gold was discovered on Tetlin Native land and is the cause of an increase of activity in Tok and along the highway to Fairbanks, where the ore will be processed.

## Travel Tips

- MOST business in Tok are open year round. Reservations from June-August are recommended.
- TOK'S summer temperature averages 60-70°F in June-August
- Bring a light jacket, good walking shoes.
- TOK'S winter temperatures average -30°F
- All major roads are maintained year-round.
- Taylor/Top of the World Highways are good seasonal (May-Sept) gravel roads. Travel at moderate speeds.
- Please allow extra time on all roads due to added seasonal traffic, mining, and road construction.
- HOMESTEADING & FREE LAND are things of the past.
- U.S. CURRENCY and credit cards are accepted at most Alaskan businesses.
- TOK has no car rental agencies.
- BUS SERVICES to Fairbanks, Anchorage, Whitehorse & Haines.
- SEATBELTS are to be worn by state law, and while headlights on during daylight is not a requirement, it is good safety practice.
- NORTHERN LIGHTS are visible August through May.
- Remember to obtain a Passport before traveling to Alaska, remember that Alaska is divided in two parts with Canada in between.
- ALASKA is a large state, a small distance on a map may take hours to drive.
- Our two main seasons are winter and road construction.
